Below is a list of books students will be required to read during the summer. Students should choose books **they have not read before**. For hesitant or unenthusiastic readers, calculate the total number of pages to be read and assign your child a specific number of pages to read each day.

To find the books, any book vendor will do, as long as the books are <u>complete and unabridged</u>. Most of these books are classics and can be found easily online (e.g., <u>www.amazon.com</u> or <u>www.bestwebbuys.com/books</u>), at your nearest Barnes & Noble, or at a local used book vendor.
